GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT WRITING:

- A. Suitable titles based on themes that have been set either in Malay, English or Arabic.
- B. Abstracts should be written using a Microsoft Word file.
- C. Title, name of author and co-author. Institution name and address. As well as the email address used for contact (corresponding author).
- D. The abstract contains information covering the purpose of the research, research methodology, research sample, research tools, data analysis, results, findings and discussion and general recommendations based on the results obtained. (Abstract elements can be adapted to the requirements of the writing if the paper is only based on the conceptual paper).
- E. Authors need to provide an abstract in Malay, English or Arabic.
- F. The length of the abstract is between 250 to 300 words only.
- G. The writer also needs to provide 4-5 keywords.
